Reimbursement forms with invoices and/or receipts for Bayside expenses – Within 30 days of expense.


Reimbursement checks to you – Please cash within 30 days of receipt.

Joyce is an Award-Winning self-taught quilter, fiber artist and author. Joyce has put out two books. **"Thread Paint A Garden Quilt**" focuses on raw edge applique and thread painting to add shading, highlighting and definition. **"Creating Art Quilts with Panels"** works with Fabric Panels to create dimension and texture with threads and embellishments.

Joyce loves to teach and share her tips. One of her greatest accomplishments is when a student creates their own Artwork following Joyce's technique of Dimensional Thread Painting!

Learn the basics of Raw Edge Applique, Dimensional Thread Painting and Embellishment on this beautiful Poppies with Bluebird wall hanging. See the fabric come to life as you sew and layer the threads on top of your design; adding shading, highlighting, texture and definition. You will use Thread as Paint –and sew with different types of threads and color combinations.

"Design Your Quilt: Tips to Take It to the Next Level"



Have you ever wanted to tweak a quilt design to give it something a little extra special? Instead of piecing complicated blocks, you can get a great effect with simple blocks, creative placement and fearless coloring. Pat will show you some approaches for transforming a ho-hum quilt to wow.

Quilt software is not necessary to apply this technique, but it goes faster with computer tools. Pat will demonstrate some useful tools in quilt design software and show how it speeds up this experimental process.
