A safety pin (provided by Bayside) will be used to attach the tag to your item.

You set the price.

Select one of the categories from the table below.

Obtain a Vendor # from Pat Massimini. Use the same number for everything you put in the Handmade Market.

Fill in the size for all quilts. You can use dimensions OR king/queen/twin/throw/lap/baby.

Size is optional for items other than quilts.

No specific format. Provide any information that might be helpful to the purchaser or to Bayside when we summarize the results of the sale.

Category	Notes for Vendors
Quilts	Includes all sizes. Note size on tag. Some children's quilts may be displayed in the section with other children's items
Wall Hangings / Table Runners	
Vintage	Older quilts, do not have to be antique
Children	Includes swaddles, fabric books, stuffed animals, dolls, children's reading pillows, etc.
Pets	Includes dog waste bags
Bags	Includes coin purses, wallets, tote bags, cosmetic bags, kits bags, drawstring bags, bags with handles, dog waste bags, grocery bags, shoe bags, project bags
Home Decor	Includes aprons, potholders, placemats, casserole carriers, rope bowls, bowl cozies, towels, pillowcases, flower arrangements, coasters, pin cushions, wine bags, candle mats
Pillows	
Christmas	Includes Christmas quilts / runners / wall hangings, trees, pillows, ornaments, stockings, wreaths, potholders, etc.
Other Holiday	Includes items for Thanksgiving, Halloween, patriotic, Chanukah and other holidays
Gift Baskets	
Wearables and Jewelry	Includes knitted or crocheted scarves, hats, gloves
Miscellaneous--Fabric	
Miscellaneous—Non-Fabric	Includes notecards, jam
