President's Corner

Greetings,

Why do we quilt? According to author Melanie Falick, "we make in order to slow down. To connect with others. To express ideas and emotions, feel competent, create something tangible and long-lasting. And to feed the soul.' Those are many reasons. But for me, it boils down to one: I have no choice.

While I came late to quilting, I have always been a maker. Using my hands to create something has always filled me with joy, even when the finished (or unfinished!) product does not. When I started quilting, I wasn't an immediate fan. I initially found it fussy, fiddly and too exacting. It required patience that at the time I didn't have. But eventually it grabbed me, and it hasn't let go.

I love the fabric, but I also love the thought of being part of something that can be traced back centuries. Something that was made for utilitarian purposes, for comfort, to raise awareness and funds for important causes, to help slaves find their way to safety, and maybe, most importantly, to connect with others.

Today, many of us quilt solely for the pleasure of creative expression. And this month we are hosting a quilter who most definitely quilts for creative expression! Eleanor (Elly) Levie joins us with a trunk show she calls "Rock Your Quilt." Featuring quilts and quilted accessories, Ellie will show us a dozen different ways to inject unique style and originality into our quilts. Then in the afternoon she will host a workshop called "Weave a Quilt With Me." Showing us how to weave with fabric strips and ribbons to form the basis of a quilt, table runner, wall hanging, pillow, bag, Christmas stocking, etc., Ellie will help us see that our only limitation is our imagination.

So, think about it - why do you quilt? And whatever the reason is, keep at it!

ALL LEVELS -- No sewing! ALL AGES--Do it with kids over 9!

Make a Skinny quilt/table runner, or wall hanging of any

size, a luxurious pillow top, a tote bag, photo album cover, or placemats.



As you weave, you'll develop a sense of design and composition, value and color, movement and shape, balance and rhythm!

Class Supply List:

First, choose a color palette for your creation to match the décor where it will go. Make sure you have similar and complementary colors in light, medium, and dark values.



- 2 yards plain, neutral fabric for a padded work surface
- 1 yard of paper-backed, heavy-duty fusible web, 17" wide
- (I recommend heavy-duty Wonder-Under)
- Scraps and/or fat eighths of fabrics in your chosen colors—at least 6 different ones
- 12"-18" lengths of ribbons, lace, rickrack, and/or flat trims in colors to match and contrast; satin ribbons are great for shine, while metallics add zing!
- · Basic rotary cutting supplies, pins and pin cushion, fabric-cutting scissors
