A Year In Color 2022

The Idea

To document a calendar year using temperature to select the colors for the quilt as the days go by.

How I did that:

20 fabrics were selected. Each color representing a 5° range.

1-5°



81-85°



16-20°



95-100°



Each column represents a week beginning with Sunday at the top. Each block shows the high and low temps for the day.

For the blocks with buttons, the number of buttons tells what month it is i.e. 6 buttons marks the beginning of June.

Maker's Statement

This was fun to do. I experimented with several layouts. A lot of time went into this but I enjoyed the discipline of tracking the temperatures and working on a project for over a year.

I'm thinking of a similar project for the year 2024-2025, the year I turn 80.

Eunice's Happy Quilt!!

Top only 46 1/2" x 48 1/2"

Fabric Cuts:

- 1 Panel 14 1/2" x WOF, (Wild Things by Julia Dobson Miner – Candy's shop)
- 4 6" x WOF background - Candy's Lightening method (right)
- 4 2 1/2" x WOF Bright - Candy's Lightening method
- 2 2 1/2" x WOF Bright (adjusting sashes, pieced blocks)
- 4 4 1/2" x WOF Borders
- 4 4 1/2" square Corner stones

Directions:

Trim panel to 40.5"

Make Lightening blocks

Sew 2 1/2" strip bright to 6" background (make 4)

Cut 6 1/2" squares at random -- wonky (askew) (make 24),

Sew sets of 4 blocks together

Sew 3 blocks together twice to make 2 rows

Add 2 1/2" strip to each side of 2 block rows. Trim to 40 1/2" if necessary

Sew 3 rows together, lightening row, panel, lightening row.

Cut side borders – cut 2 strips to 38 1/2"

Sew side borders

Cut top & bottom borders to 40 1/2"

Sew corner stones to each

Sew top & bottom borders

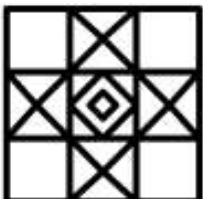
